Thank you so much for cleaning the old Cooper Cemetery on the road to the Perrysburg Hospital. It has been a job I've wanted to get done for several years.

It is the family cemetery of William Cooper and most people buried in it were either related or very early settlers in Perrysburg with the Coopers. William Cooper owned most of the land on which the village stands and <sup>the</sup> four-corners was called Cooper's Corners. Mr. Cooper ran a tavern on the corner across from the fire-hall and before Civil War was one of the agents of Underground Railroad to get slaves to safety in Canada.

It is one of the spots of historic interest in our town, so thank you again for a very good job done.
